2 cups All purpose Flour 3 tbsp Unsalted Butter 2 tbsp White Sugar 2 tsp Baking Powder 2/3 cup Whole Milk a pinch of salt

Put Flour into bowl, then add the Unsalted Butter, (I cut the butter into tiny pieces to work with it easier). Add Sugar, Baking Powder and Salt and mix together. It will still look like flour. Maybe a bit crumb-like. Add Milk slowly till all the ingredients are wet. Do not add all the milk at once. You have to make sure that the dough is not too sticky, but also not too dry. If you need more milk, you can add another drop. Form into ball.
