*Diocese Investment Trust Account Endowment showed a balance of 403,845.40 with a discrepancy of \$29,947.91. \$28,865. was net gain loss during 4th quarter, \$82.80 is being researched. (page 13)

Living Stones Parish Hall Kitchen Renovation Presentation: Living Stones Team (Handout)

*Presentation regarding three options: Minimal, Middle and Full Vision Renovation.

*The Minimal Vision Renovation is what is required by the town to receive certification. Counter top on the island would be stainless steel; that counter is too long for a seamless Formica countertop. Other counters would remain Formica. Dumpster would be enclosed.

*Discussion regarding kitchen door replacement, and option for keyless entry. Consult with Chelmsford Lock and Key. Cost of keyless entry would be included in Living Stones quote.

*Commercial Stove/Oven discussion: \$3,500. for gas burners vs. \$11,000. for electric start. Explore maintenance contract for periodic cleaning of new stove and grease traps.

*Additional discussion regarding dishwasher and 3 bay sink replacement, modifying existing cabinets, replacing linoleum floor and storage closet reorganization.

*Time Frame: 5-6 weeks. May need to close kitchen for about 2 weeks. Liz mentioned that Feeding Program leaders need to be contacted. Suggest that it be done before Christmas Fair and Pie Baking fundraisers.

<u>MOTION:</u> "Move to authorize the Living Stones Capital Implementation Committee to disburse \$46,059.00 to fund the Full Vision (Option 1) Parish Hall Kitchen Renovation to be performed in accordance with the plan as presented to the Vestry. Furthermore, the Wardens are authorized to establish a legal contract with a Contractor determined by the Implementation Committee to accomplish this work on terms as presented to the Vestry."
